Halifax is strategically located between major North American, European, and Asian markets, making it an excellent location for moving goods in and out of North America and traveling to and from international destinations—by road, rail, air, and sea.

HALIFAX STANFIELD INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

- Largest international airport in Atlantic Canada and only US pre-clearance facility.
- Daily flights from Halifax to New York, Boston, and Montréal take less than two hours.
- Ample cargo handling capacity and easy transport of perishable and non-perishable products.
- 40K sq. ft. air cargo facility and 7K square foot climate controlled space with airside access.



PORT OF HALIFAX

- · Closest major port to Europe one full day faster to Europe than other North American east coast container ports.
- Deep, ice-free port with spare capacity and Super Post-Panamax vessel handling capabilities.
- World's largest shipping lines call on the Port of Halifax, connecting to 150+ countries.
- Deepest container berths on the east coast of North America.



CN RAIL

- Daily rail service to central Canada and the US Midwest.
- CN Main Line and CN Intermodal Facility with on dock rail at both container terminals in the Port of Halifax.
- Specialized rail equipment for bulk, breakbulk, heavy-lift, and containerized cargo.
- CN owned Autoport is one of North America's largest vehicle processing and transshipment facilities.


