

What is Apprenticeship?

Apprenticeship is a post-secondary career pathway that combines hands on learning and theory

Three Pathways to Apprenticeship

High School Graduate

Youth Apprenticeship Age 16 -19 work part-time while completing high school

Direct Entry - Start working in skilled trade. Earn wages while working toward certification

Accumulate apprenticeship hours under journeyperson

Enroll in Pre-Apprenticeship Program

Attend NSCC for foundational skills

Accumulate apprenticeship hours in NSCC classroom

Must still register for formal apprenticeship

Secure an employer & journeyperson

Register as an apprentice

Sign formal apprenticeship agreement

Accumulate hours and level training

Write certification exam
